

Odisha Procurement Preference Policy for MSEs-2015

Introduction

The Govt in MSME Department Odisha, vide Notification No 4318/MSME dtd.10.06.2015, have the "Odisha Procurement Preference Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises,2015" with an objective to provide and ensure fair, transparent, consistent, rationally equitable procurement practices of good and services, produced and provided by the MSEs of Odisha.

FAQ on Odisha Procurement Preference Policy for MSEs-2015

Q. Which MSEs are eligible to avail the benefits under this policy?

MSEs of the state with registration certificate/EM Part -II by RIC/DIC or registered with KVIC or Odisha Khadi and Village Industries Board or NSIC or Directorate of Handicraft and Cottage Industries or Directorate of Textiles or any other body specified by Ministry of NSME, Gol and MSEs covered under "Public Procurement Preference Policy for MSEs Order 2012" of Gol.

Q. Who is the Nodal Agency of this policy?

Director EP&M is the nodal agency for implementation of the provisions of the policy

Q. What is mandatory procurement from MSEs?

State Government Departments and Agencies shall procure minimum 20% of the value of their requirement from local MSEs for the reserve items under this policy.

Q. Is there any specific provisions for MSEs owned by SC/ST/Women?

Out of 20% target of annual procurement a sub target of 20% shall be earmarked for procurement from MSEs owned by SC/ST/Physically challenged/Women/Degree and Diploma holding Entrepreneurs.

Q. What are the Marketing support/assistance available under this policy?

Marketing support / assistance like purchase through rate contract, Exclusive list, price preference (10%) and additional price preference (3%), Exemption of EMD, Subsidised security deposit (25%), exemption from minimum turnover criteria are available to the local MSEs.

Q. What is the grievance redressal procedure for any dispute?

A grievance cell set up in MSME department to redress the grievances of MSEs in respect of procurement preference including imposition of unreasonable conditions in tenders floated by Government Departments.
